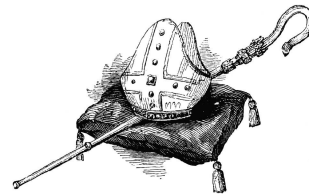


On May 29, 2017, it was announced that Pope Francis has appointed Bishop-elect William A. Wack (pronounced “wok”) the sixth Bishop of our diocese.

Bishop-elect Wack will be ordained a bishop and installed at a Mass on Tuesday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> at 2:00pm at the Pensacola Bay Center. A reception will follow at the Cathedral from 6:00 to 8:00pm, and all are invited.
